${ }^{1}$ Afterward Jesus returned to Jerusalem for one of the Jewish holy days. ${ }^{2}$ Inside the city, near the Sheep Gate, was the pool of Bethesda, with five covered porches. ${ }^{3}$ Crowds of sick people-blind, lame, or paralyzed-lay on the porches.

[ ${ }^{4}$ For an angel went down at a certain time into the pool and stirred up the water; then whoever stepped in first, after the stirring of the water, was made well of whatever disease he had.]

${ }^{5}$ One of the men lying there had been sick for thirty-
eight years. ${ }^{6}$ When Jesus saw him and knew he had been
ill for a long time, he asked him, "Would you like to get well?" 7 "I can't, sir," the sick man said, "for I have no one to put me into the pool when the water bubbles up. Someone else always gets there ahead of me."

John 5
${ }^{8}$ Jesus told him, "Stand up, pick up your mat, and walk!" ${ }^{9}$ Instantly, the man was healed! He rolled up his sleeping mat and began walking!


## The wholeness Jesus offers is often at odds with our imagined solutions

John 5
${ }^{9 b}$ But this miracle happened on the Sabbath, ${ }^{10}$ so the Jewish leaders objected. They said to the man who was cured, "You can't work on the Sabbath! The law doesn't allow you to carry that sleeping mat!" ${ }^{11}$ But he replied, "The man who healed me told me, 'Pick up your mat and walk.'"

12 "Who said such a thing as that?" they demanded. 13
The man didn't know, for Jesus had disappeared into the crowd.


The wholeness Jesus offers is distinct from a life of religious obligation

${ }^{14}$ But afterward Jesus found him in the Temple and told him, "Now you are well; so stop sinning, or something even worse may happen to you." ${ }^{15}$ Then the man went and told the Jewish leaders that it was Jesus who had healed him.
