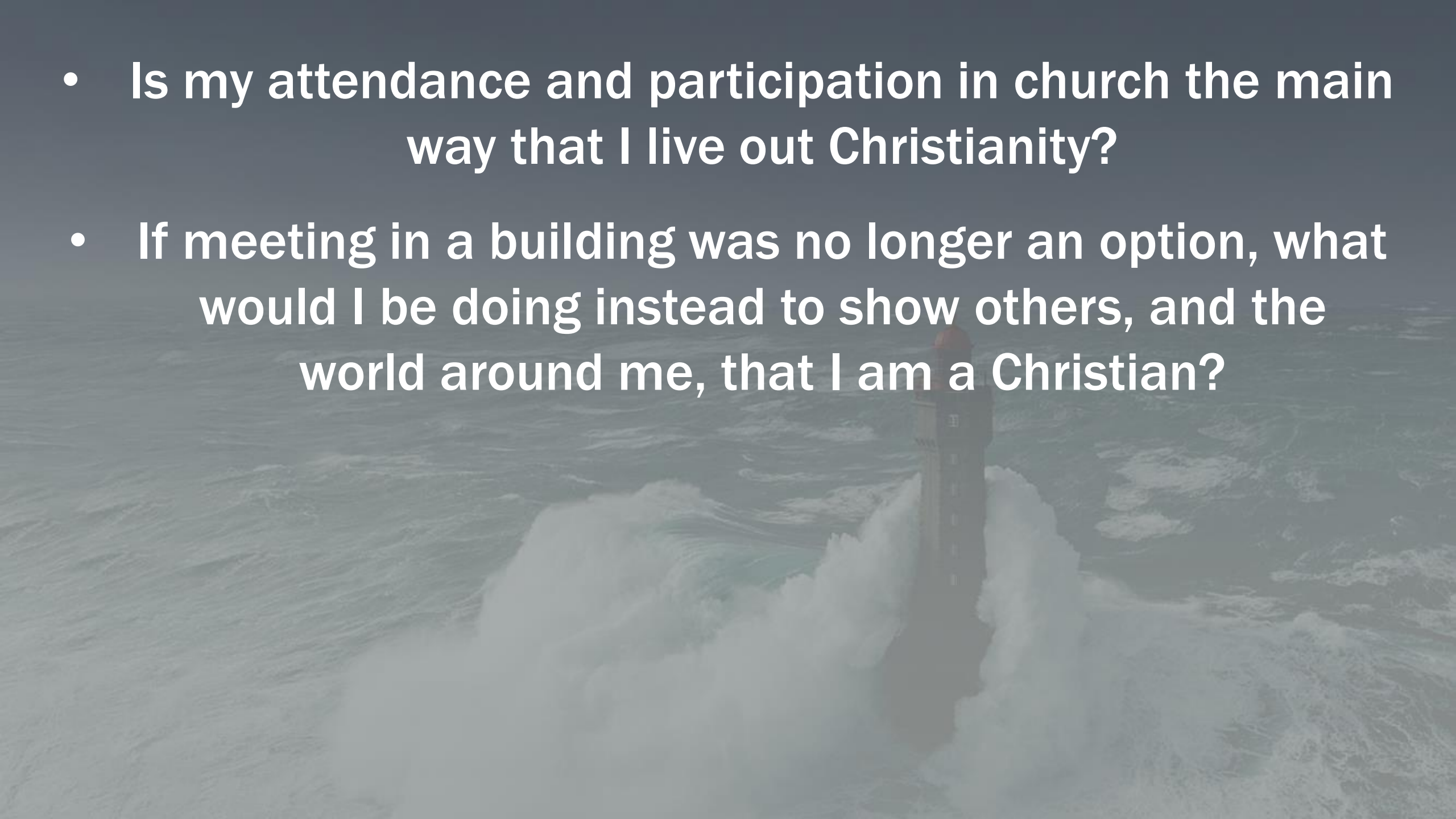




Matthew 5




Ephesians 4
