"The reason that this story was so sensational was that it is, unfortunately, the exception to the rule...That is not to say that the average person is not empathetic, or that they would not help someone in need if they felt that they had the ability, but there are a lot of impeding factors that bias us away from action during emergency situations...

there's the confusion that accompanies these situations....The questions of — what should I do? Do they actually need my help? There's the panic. There's the uncertainty. There's the lack of organization. There's the belief that someone more qualified should step in....

But, defying all that logic, an estimated 80 people - many of whom never received any recognition — headed directly into the rip current. Which leads to the question - why was this moment different? What it likely boils down to is, as studies show, is this: human behavior is contagious.

This is true for bad things — for example if a friend becomes obese, studies show you are more likely to become obese — and good things, like being willing to form a human chain."
